Everett Transit is planning to improve bus stops along Broadway between 34th Street and 7th Street during spring and summer of 2017. There will be stop additions and relocations.

The purpose of this work is to add “bus bulbs”—a cement pad that projects out from the curb—to each of the bus stops within the corridor. This will allow for improved safety, shorter stop times and more parking. New amenities will also be added to most stops.

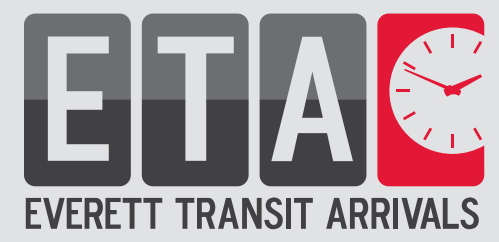

EVERETT TRANSIT ARRIVALS

ETA is an automated system that provides real-time bus arrival information. When you call or text the ETA phone number and input the bus stop number, the system provides the estimated time of arrival for all Everett Transit routes serving the stop.
