PARADE SHUTTLE

Park and catch the shuttle from:
 Everett Station, Bay D1/D2, 3201 Smith Ave.
 Schedule: The shuttle leaves operates to and from downtown every 5 minutes from 9:30 - 11 a.m. before the parade and noon - 2 p.m. after the parade.

FESTIVAL & FIREWORKS SHUTTLE

Take the shuttle to Legion Park for the Fireworks Festival!

Park & catch the shuttle from two locations:
 - Everett Community College Walt Price Fitness Center, 2206 Tower St.
 - Everett Station, Bay D1/D2 3201 Smith Ave.

Schedule: Festival shuttles leave every 20 minutes from 12:30 - 9:30 p.m. (The last shuttle to the Fireworks Festival leaves at 9:30 p.m. - no additional shuttles to the show will operate after this time). Return shuttles to both parking locations are offered after the show.
